NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the ISA will apply.
- 1.3 Rules of the Sigma 33 Offshore One Design Class will apply.
- 1.4 Entrants may be required to carry advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Sigma 33 Offshore One Design Class. Helmsman must be registered members of the Sigma 33 OOD Class Association.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Royal St George Yacht Club by June 1st 2010.
- 2.3 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Committee, subject to the payment of a late entry surcharge.
- 2.4 All entrants must produce a valid measurement certificate at registration.

3 FEES

Required fees are as follows: € 125.00 per Boat. (£ 110.00) Late Entry Surcharge (After June 9th 2010) € 25 (£ 22.50)

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Briefing – A Briefing will be held in Royal St George yacht Club at 9:00 on Friday 11th June 2010

- 4.2 Registration and Inspection:

Thursday 10th June 2010 From 19:00 to 21:00

- 4.3 Dates of racing:

Friday 11 th June	Races 1, 2, 3 and 4	Note: One extra race per day may be sailed at the discretion of the Race Officer (max 10 race series)
Saturday 12 th June	Races 5, 6 and 7	
Sunday 13 th June	Races 8, 9 and 10	

- 4.4 The scheduled time of the first warning signal each day is 10:25 except that on Friday 11th June the scheduled time of the first warning signal is 10:55.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be sent to entrants on receipt of signed entry form and entry fee except that late entrants may collect sailing instructions on registration.

6 SAILING AREA

The Sailing Area will be in Dublin Bay.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward-Leeward.

8 SCORING

8.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 After four races have been sailed the Silver Fleet will be identified as follows: The results will be taken without discard and the number of entrants divided by two (rounded down if there is an uneven number). The second half of the fleet will comprise the Silver Fleet. Separate results will be published for both fleets.

9 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

10 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 PRIZES

Daily Prizes will be presented following racing on 11th, 12th and 13th June.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

14.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1,500,000.00 or the equivalent.
